### 1.3 Draw modus

The seeding and draw-en-bock will be made on Thursday November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2023 at 18:00 hour  
Immediately after the draw has been finalised, the categories will be made available online on the Sportdata Event Website. JJNOs have the right to request minor changes<sup>2</sup> in the following 2 hours, in writing, to the Sport Director of JJEU. ([sport.director@jjeu.eu](mailto:sport.director@jjeu.eu))

Major changes<sup>3</sup> must be requested according to the following<sup>4</sup>:

- At international events, no redraw is possible except for unforeseen cases when the OC may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. two hours after the draw was published, but, in any case, before the start of the competition, in writing, to the OC.

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed. For the seeding, JJIF will use the world ranking list and registration for the event from October 16<sup>th</sup>. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in the raking list until this day.

## 6 Right to participate and categories

Adults:

Each JJNO may enter TWO (2) contestants in each category for the European Championship Adults.

Categories Masters:

The age following age categories<sup>5</sup> will be allowed to participate in the Master event

## 7 European Teams Nations CUP. (Sunday November 26th)

Disciplines & Categories:

We will have two discipline, Fighting and JiuJitsu. Both have their own Nations CUP.

Jiu-Jitsu ▪ Men: -69kg, - 85kg, +85kg ▪ Women: -63kg, +63kg

Fighting ▪ Men: -69kg, - 85kg, +85kg ▪ Women: -63kg, +63kg

Minimum of athletes per team to register to the event (each federation is allowed to have 2 teams in each of the two disciplines(fighting and jiuJitsu))

Winner: ▪ Team who reaches first to 3 wins.

Each federation must overhand his TEAM(s) written on paper to the Sport director of JJEU not later than Saturday November 25<sup>th</sup> at 19:00 hour.

## 8 Registration and Participation Fee

### 1.1 Participation Fee

**150 €** per individual athlete - and **150 €** per duo / show couple

**150 €** Per team (payment for teams must be done in cash on Sunday before competition starts)

(60 € participation / 10 € Doping Free contribution / 80 € Referee contribution)

- Change (of an injured) competitor until registration deadline: free
- Change (of an injured) competitor after registration deadline (in the same category): €15
- Change of the category of an athlete: €15
- Late entry: €25
- Late payments (after date of October 27<sup>th</sup> 2023) €10 per entry.
- Additional entering of a competitor on site: €75

### 1.2 Financial conditions

The organisation of the travel to the event and travel expenses are the responsibility of the participating countries. Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation to local the organiser.

Payment must be done by bank transfer until October 25<sup>th</sup> 2023 or take pre-approval that you will pay cash at the official registration and accreditation. No accommodation or registration refund for participants not attending the Championship will be made.

## 2 Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations<sup>7</sup>.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2023 Prohibited List (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-is-prohibited>)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognises all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so don't hesitate to get in touch with your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, don't hesitate to get in touch with the JJIF.

### 3 Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements & Advertising

The national federations purchase the back numbers for all JJEU events, at the following link, from Ju-Sports, the premium sponsor of the JJEU:

The JJNOs are then responsible for giving the back numbers to the athletes so that they can apply them to their Gi prior to the competition. The national federations must pay the back numbers for their athletes by themselves. Participating without an official back number is not allowed.

AS OF 01-01-2023 JJEU has new designed back patches. All athletes MUST have the new backpatches, these patches can be ordered via: [https://www.sportundspiel99.de/c99802203-JJEU\\_Back-numbers](https://www.sportundspiel99.de/c99802203-JJEU_Back-numbers). It's not allowed to use old or None.

Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned.

### 4 Referees

For these upcoming European Championship, JJEU and the Croatian federation of Jujitsu will be able to provide some compensation to the selected referees in terms of travel and accommodation, also day money of 200 euro per day is managed.

The JJEU Board and JJEU Sport Director and the JJEU Head referees are entrusted with the task to select the qualified referees for the event for each discipline at this event. (9 DUO/Fighting, 7 Fighting and 8 JiuJitsu and 3 head referees)

Referees should attend the briefing meeting on WEDNESDAY (22<sup>nd</sup> of November 2023 17:00) afternoon. Referee MUST attend the **whole** competition at the event, early leaving is NOT possible.

Neither the organizing committee nor the JJEU will be responsible for not respecting this obligation. However, if there won't be enough referees for the competition to take place in good conditions, JJEU Referee Committee may decide to complement the pool of referees with national referees of the organizing federation. For the referees there is a own Sportdata page created, referees must insert themselves and should not be done by the federations.

### 5 Coaches & Medical personnel from JJNOs

#### 5.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches).

#### 5.2 Medical personnel

JJNOS may have its medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel the, attendance at the medical meeting<sup>8</sup> is mandatory.

### 5.3 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses<sup>9</sup>; shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person.

## 6 Flags and Anthems

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible for each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

## 7 Visa

The Organizer is happy to help any country obtain a visa for athletes and officials. For nations that need a VISA to enter the country, please send the Organizer as soon as possible (latest **Date**) a list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth and positions. (Add Passport Picture, please)

**Deadline for VISA support 20<sup>th</sup> of October 2023** - *after this date, you must take care of the VISA yourself, or additional costs will apply.*
